





Reserve Petite Sirah

California 2019

Blend: 100% Petite Sirah

Tasting Notes:

Flavors and Aromas: A velvet curtain envelops the senses, rich with classic Petite Sirah aromas and elevated by silky and graceful notes on the palate. Enjoy scents of violet, plum, clove, allspice, vanilla, and black pepper, all flowing into the palate where they join a supportive base of dark fruit framed by lingering spice.

Body and Structure: This vintage is smooth yet structured, with balance in each sip.

Pairings: Chicken in mole sauce, melted swiss cheese, aged gouda, balsamic rosemary burgers, eggplant parmigian.

Details:

With fewer than 10,000 acres of Petite Sirah vines planted globally, this varietal is actually quite a rare find. This vintage is composed of 100% Livermore Valley estate grown Petite Sirah, aged in 75% new oak, a mix of French (47%), American (33%) and Hungarian (20%) oak for 21 months prior to bottling. This wine takes well to decanting.
