Blend: 100% Petite Sirah

Tasting Notes:

Flavors and Aromas: An opulent aroma, plush with dark berry, black pepper, toasted oak, and vanilla opens this wine. On the palate, a velvet curtain of dark chocolate, black tea, and spice notes descends. Fruit flavors move into the spotlight, lush with black fruit and French plum.

Body and Structure: Rich. Bold. Beautiful. The mouthfeel is medium weight and the finish is enticingly flavorful.

Pairings: Chicken in mole sauce, melted swiss cheese, aged gouda, balsamic rosemary burgers, eggplant parmigian.

Details:

With fewer than 10,000 acres of Petite Sirah vines planted globally, this varietal is actually quite a rare find. This vintage is composed of 100% Livermore Valley estate grown Petite Sirah, aged in a mix of 60% new French (21%), American (48%) and Hungarian (31%) oak for 21 months prior to bottling. Intense, rich, and deliciously approachable, this wine takes well to decanting.
