



Peacock Patch Zinfandel

Livermore Valley

Blend: 94% Zinfandel & 6% Primitivo

Tasting Notes:

Flavors and Aromas: The aromas are dense with varied fruit, such as cherries, dried cranberries, dates, raspberries, figs and plums.

Body and Structure: On the palate the tannins are very smooth. A little bit of vanilla from the oak peaks through along with a hint of black pepper. This wine has a mild body with fruit flavors lingering on the finish.

Pairings: Pairs nicely with bold flavored food like BBQ, pizza and stews.

Details:

The soil in this block is very gravelly and not particularly fertile, resulting in slightly stressed vines which produce fruit with a great concentration of flavor. This wine was aged in a mix of 33% new American and French oak for 20 months prior to bottling.
